There is some limited space available in a display cabinet for small sculptures or jewelry which will be allocated on a first registered, first served basis.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Submit family friendly work suitable for a lobby in a public office building.
- All styles from traditional to abstract to conceptual are welcome and encouraged.
- Small-medium sculptures, fine jewelry and 3D works accepted. (Helpful if artist can supply pedestal, but not mandatory). There is limited tabletop and display cabinet space for the sculptures so they are accepted on a first registered, first served basis. Please contact us with any questions **WELL** in advance of delivery date.
- All works must be **WIRED** and ready for hanging. **No sawtooth or other type of hanging hardware will be accepted.** If you have any questions email us **WELL** in advance of delivery date.

Labels for the exhibition are prepared in advance, so your email submission must include ALL of the following for EACH PIECE. Please follow this EXACT format FOR EACH PIECE and submit in regular text in the body of your email (not as an image, not as a PDF, etc.) The info you provide is copied and pasted to create your label(s).

- GAL reserves the right to refuse any works that are unsafe, improperly framed or wired, still wet, or unsuitable for hanging in any other way.
- Works must be delivered and retrieved on dates and times indicated. This is a public lobby space. **Artworks cannot be stored.** If you have any problems with the agreed upon times, contact GAL via email WELL in advance. If you cannot pick up your works as indicated, please make arrangements with a representative to do so. If a



representative is dropping off your work, be certain that they have ALL the necessary information and are prepared to take the time to sign in for you properly.

- Only artworks will be accepted at the site. All protective wrappings and carrying devices must be removed by artist/representative and taken from premises.
- All works must remain until the end date of the show. If you wish to remove a piece that has been sold, Goshen Art League must be notified, and the piece must be replaced with a work of the same size. A REPRESENTATIVE OF GAL MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL TIMES FOR THE REMOVAL OR INSTALLATION OF ANY ARTWORK FOR ANY REASON. All communications regarding anything to do with the exhibition should be addressed to Goshen Art League at: goshenartleague@gmail.com and NOT to any individual's private email, text, or FB messenger.
- Upon delivery of your work, you will be asked to indicate some sort of finger food or beverage you may like to contribute for the reception. Both savory and sweet items that can be eaten without utensils and from a napkin are welcome. Please no alcoholic beverages.

Please consider that your work is accepted into the exhibit UNLESS you hear otherwise via return email. Depending on time constraints, individual submissions may not always be acknowledged.

** BRIDGES

A bridge is a structure built to span physical obstacles without closing the way underneath such as a body of water, valley, or road, for the purpose of providing passage over the obstacle, usually something that can be detrimental to cross otherwise.

A bridge is also a structure which enables different functions. As a metaphor, a bridge between people enables the passage of ideas, it connects people who are in different places, it enables help to be connected, it opens up the opportunity for people to be helped, it reduces isolation, it is a more efficient way of getting to another point, it increases a range of options.
